

ABOUT MILSET ESA 2022




Those standards are genuinely among the best and most current internationally recognised standards as they are compatible with the latest scientific theories and best international practices in gifted education and talent development.

Entry requirements for visitors ages 18 and above

If you are vaccinated:

You must present proof of at least one dose of any COVID vaccine recognized by any Expo 2020 participating country or the World Health Organisation (WHO).

If you are unvaccinated:

You must present a negative PCR test certificate for a test conducted within the last 72 hours. Please take the PCR test at least one day before your visit to Expo as results will take up to 10 hours. You will not be allowed into the site without a negative PCR test result.

Expo 2020 Dubai is a celebration of human brilliance and achievement. It will be an opportunity for people to connect from different corners of the world, to experience the best of art, geography, science, technology, culture. innovation, and invention and to set into motion millions of new thoughts and ideas that will make a lasting impact in our lives.

The UAE has shown the world what is possible throughout its history through its remarkable development. With Expo 2020 Dubai, Dubai will go a step further in inspiring the next generation to spark innovations that will underline the next 50 years of human progress.

Mohammed bin Rashid Space Center (MBRSC)

* Special requirements:

Need PCR test - with a maximum of 48 hrs. Before tour.

Description:

The Mohammed Bin Rashid Space Centre, founded in 2006, is home to the UAE National Space Programme. The Centre builds and operates earth observation satellites, offering imaging and data analysis services to clients worldwide. The Centre launched DubaiSat-1, DubaiSat-2, and recently launched KhalifaSat on 29 October 2018 from Tanegashima Space Center in Japan. KhalifaSat was developed 100% in the UAE by a team of highly qualified Emirati engineers.

The Centre is responsible for developing the Emirates Mars Mission and the Mars Hope Probe, a mission to reach Mars orbit by 2021 and gather key science data about Mars' atmosphere, and the development of the Mars 2117 vision to build a human colony on Mars. It also collects the UAE Astronaut Programme, which saw the launch of Hazzaa AlMansoori, the first Emirati Astronaut, to the International Space Station on a scientific mission on 25 September 2019.







Al Shindagha Museum

Description:

Set along the historic waters of Dubai Creek, Al Shindagha Museum tells the proud story of the nation's past and reverent traditions. The museum's 'Dubai Creek: Birth of a City is a state-of-the-art multimedia experience that guides visitors through the area's dramatic development over centuries. The carefully-curated tour features interactive videos, touch displays, and historic photographs and artefacts so visitors can gain insight into what it was like for Emiratis to raise a family by the waterways and how maritime trade affected their livelihoods.

Afterwards, stop by the Perfume House and discover the story behind Emirati fragrances. It highlights how scents played an integral role in the nation's history with a legacy that still lives on today. Visitors can explore Emirati culture via scent and learn stories associated with the perfumes that played an integral role in trade within the Emirates. Breathing new life to one of the city's oldest neighbourhoods, Al Shindagha Museum offers an inimitable glimpse into Dubai's vibrant past.

You can also find the Gold Souk (Gold Market), the finest clothing stores. The Dubai Mall is the ultimate family entertainment destination with The Dubai Aquarium and Underwater Zoo, the Olympic-sized Dubai Ice Rink, the children's 'edutainment' concept KidZania and a massive indoor cinema complex amenities.

Do not miss the indoor fountain (one of the most photographed spots in the mall), or The Village, which features a retractable roof opened in the winter months to offer shoppers an outdoor experience.



- Laser more than 5 milliwatts
- Endangered animals and embryos
- Live animals
- Human material or tissue
- The use of living organisms in experiments, studies, etc., should be carried out with ethics, as they deserve care and respect.
- The use of hazardous substances, inflammable material or handling of fire is prohibited in the exhibition for the safety of all participants, visitors, and the environment.

Restricted Items and Actions

- Research on vertebrates. They must obtain legal permits if they exist, follow a code of ethics, and should be protected and used with care. It is recommended to use invertebrates and cells. Genetic Engineering: For the use of these articles, permission must be requested from the Organising Committee.
- The Ministry of Interior (MoI) recently announced the use of "drones, including drones and light sports aircrafts" is being banned.




Safety and Security Procedures



We recommend using **Pritt/Blu tack** and **domestic adhesive tapes such as 3M double-sided** tape to mount any posters. Industrial-type adhesives are prohibited (brown cello tape, transparent tape, duct tape, or masking tape).

Participants should avoid displaying any poster content related to religion, politics, race, gender, and nudity. The Organising Committee reserves the right to remove any poster they consider inappropriate.

- Participants must keep track of travel requirements for Dubai which are being updated regularly.

Participants are kindly required to get global multi-risk travel insurance.

UAE Healthcare Official App

All participants are kindly required to download **ALHOSN app** before arriving in Dubai.

Al Hosn is the UAE's official app for contact, tracing, and monitoring health status related to COVID-19. Al Hosn app has features to protect your health. **Download or update the app to see your status (green, grey, or red) based on your most recent RT-PCR test and vaccination status, as well as vaccination information and certificate, any travel testing, and a live QR code.**

Benefits:

- Al Hosn's colour coding system helps authorities identify individuals' health status and permit them to go to public spaces and workplaces.
- Parents and guardians can add their family members and access the test results of their dependents.


The app is currently available in Arabic, English and Hindi. You can download it from the **App Store, Google Play, Huawei App Gallery, and Galaxy Store for free.**

- Register and authenticate by entering your Emirates ID or Unified ID and mobile number followed by the OTP sent to your phone.
- An internet connection is required when you first install the Al Hosn app. However, since the telecom operators safelist the app in the UAE, the data you use will not be counted against your quota.
- If you do not have a smartphone, you can use the Al Hosn web application with your web browser to log in and check your status.

Note:

The Al Hosn app stores your personal information encrypted. When the app communicates with other phones, your personal information is anonymized.

It is mandatory to turn on Bluetooth and push notifications on your smartphone.



UAE GOODS REGULATIONS

Security & Customs

Security checks are in place to ensure everyone's safety, but we appreciate it may be time-consuming. Here is what you can do to run things smoothly when arriving in the UAE.

Security Tips

• Place loose items such as mobile phone, wallet, watch, keys in your hand baggage.

- Place your charged laptop within reach as you will need to place it in a security tray for customs to scan.
- If your belt has a metal buckle, or your shoes have heels, take them off and place them in a security tray.

• Place liquid containers in a clear, resealable plastic bag in your hand baggage. Liquid containers cannot exceed 100 ml. Exemptions will be made for medication, baby milk/foods and food for special dietary requirements to be consumed during your trip.

Hand luggage

Ensure you are not carrying any prohibited items as hand luggage. Check with your airline beforehand on item restrictions.

Customs

Like all countries, the UAE has rules about what you can and can't bring with you. Everyone who arrives must pass through customs, so please check the list below beforehand. Some items can result in fines or, in cases such as narcotic drugs, imprisonment.

If you are unsure about anything, please declare your goods when you arrive.

Personal allowances

- Cash above AED 100,000 must be declared.
- Medication: A maximum three-month supply of medication for your personal use. Please include an original prescription from a registered medical practitioner.

All medications should be in original packaging and not expired. No psychotropic medicines are allowed (even for personal use, in small quantity and/or with prescription) without prior approval from the Ministry of Health.

Items you cannot bring into the UAE

- All narcotic drugs
- Gambling tools, machines
- Ivory and rhinoceros' horn
- Trammel (fishing net with three layers)
- Forged or duplicate currency
- Any printed material that contradicts Islamic teachings and/or decency, or that deliberately implies immorality or turmoil
- Cooked and homemade foods
- Radios, self-defence equipment, sharp-edged knives and swords
- Weapons, ammunition and military equipment
- Fireworks and explosives
- Trees, plants and soil
- Requirements are subject to change. Please consult Dubai Customs for additional details on entry requirements

Currency

The Emirate Dirham is the official currency of the UAE, abbreviated officially as AED. Unofficial abbreviation includes Dh and Dhs. The Dirham is divided into 100 fills.

Coins are available in the following denominations: AED 25, 1 fill, and 50 fills.

Notes are available in the denominations of AED 500, 200, 100, 50, 20, 10, and 1000.

Exchange rate

The UAE Dirham average rate related to USD and Euro is

1 USD = 3.67 AED

1 EURO = 4.01 AED

Currency exchanges can be found at the airport and in most shopping malls and will generally offer a better rate of exchange than banks, especially for larger amounts.

Weather

During MILSET ESA Dubai 2022 week, the weather forecast in Dubai will approximately be around 19°C to 25°C.

Walking Around

Walking around Pedestrians should always observe the "walking man" signs at crossings and use the bridges and underpasses on major roads when available. It is not customary for vehicles to stop for pedestrians on crossings without lights, so always wait for a sufficient gap in traffic before stepping out.

SIM Cards

The international code for the UAE is +971. You can purchase SIM cards at airports or in malls. Please consider that your passport will be required. Hotels do provide free Wi-Fi Internet, as do some shopping malls.

Communication Apps

Please note that not all video-calling or VoIP apps are used in the UAE. To get in touch with family and friends from home during your stay in Dubai, we ask you to please consider an app that is used in the UAE, and one that works best for you. Here are some recommendations of calling apps:

Dress Code

Please ensure your attire throughout your trip considers the local customs and culture in the UAE. It is not legally enforced, so observing it is a simple courtesy to your hosts. It is requested that:

- In the case women wear skirts, they should be knee-length, and tops must cover the shoulders.
- Men should also keep their shoulders covered.
- Tattoos and piercings are best kept covered in public places.

The dress code for MILSET ESA Dubai 2022 is formal. Please note shorts and flip-flops are not permitted.

Public Conduct Recommendations

During ESA activities, consumption of alcohol is prohibited.

- Consumption, purchase, and sale of drugs in the UAE is illegal and has extremely serious legal consequences. This includes bringing illegal drugs into the country.
- Using offensive gestures and hand signals to members of the public are to be avoided, especially in traffic situations. They may result in a complaint to the police and possible prosecution.
- Couples are expected not to be overly physically demonstrative in public, but holding hands is acceptable. In general, all public signs of affection should be avoided.



PLACES TO VISIT IN DUBAI

An experience beyond your imagination!

Burj Khalifa

Dubai's landmark building and major tourist attraction is the Burj Khalifa, which at 829.8 meters is the tallest building in the world and the most famous of the city's points of interest.

For most visitors, a trip to the observation deck on the 124th floor here is a must-do while in the city. The views across the city skyline from this bird's-eye perspective are simply staggering.

Dubai Museum



Dubai's excellent museum is housed in the Al-Fahidi Fort, built-in 1787 to defend Dubai Creek. The fort's walls are made out of traditional coral blocks and held together with lime. Wooden poles support the upper floor, and the ceiling is constructed from palm fronds, mud, and plaster. The fort has a fascinating history. It served as a residence for the ruling family, a seat of government, garrison, and prison. Restored in 1971 (and again extensively in 1995), it is now the city's premier museum.

The entrance has a fascinating exhibition of old maps of the Emirates and Dubai, showing the mammoth expansion that hit the region after the oil boom.

Al Fahidi Quarter (Old Dubai)



The Al Fahidi Quarter (previously known, and sometimes still referred to as the Bastakia neighbourhood) was built in the late 19th century to be the home of wealthy Persian merchants who dealt mainly in pearls and textiles and were lured to Dubai because of the tax-free trading and access to Dubai Creek.

Al Fahidi occupies the eastern portion of Bur Dubai along the creek, and the coral and limestone buildings here, many with walls topped with wind towers, have been excellently preserved.

Souks of Deira



Deira lies on the northern bank of Dubai Creek, and the winding streets here unveil the melting pot of different nationalities that have come to call Dubai home. Ancient dhows load and unload on the shore with modern banks, hotels, and office buildings as a backdrop.

For travellers, Deira is most famous for its traditional souks (markets), which bustle with shoppers at all times of the day. Deira Gold Souk is world-renowned as the largest gold bazaar in the world. The Deira Spice Souk sells every imaginable spice, with stalls overflowing with bags of frankincense, cumin, paprika, saffron, sumac, and thyme, as well as the fragrant oud wood, rose water, and incense.

Dubai Frame



Sitting slap-bang between Dubai's older neighbourhoods clustered around the creek and the city's modern sprawl, this enormous 150-meter-high picture frame is one of Dubai's latest sights.

Inside, a series of galleries whisk you through the city's history and explore Emirati heritage before you travel up to the Sky Deck, where there are fantastic panoramas of both old and new Dubai to be snapped on the viewing platforms. **Desert Safari**



It is a unique way to experience the UAE naturals terrain. The off-road Arabian adventure takes you from the city to the golden dunes of the desert. The Arabian roller coaster ride known as dune bashing (desert driving) will offer adventures seekers thrill of a ride.
